

## Visas, Immigration and Medical

### Student Visa

#### Application for Student Visa

Application for student Visa should be made to the Passport and Immigration Office by the respective tertiary educational institution where the student is enrolled.

After relevant payment (tuition fees), the student must send the following documents by express courier to our Future Students Centre at Charles Telfair Campus in Mauritius:

#### Documents to be submitted for Student Visa:

- Form "Application to Enter Mauritius" duly filled in, dated and signed by the applicant **(Original)**
- Four recent passport size photographs of the applicant
- Photocopy of the bio-data pages of the passport of the applicant beyond period of stay
- Letter of offer from institution
- Letter of acceptance from student **(Original)**
- Letter of sponsorship from parents or guardian, copy of ID or passport of parents or guardian **(Original)**
- Documentary evidence of availability of funds or financial capacity - bank statements of parents or guardian for a period of last 6 months to meet costs of study and stay in Mauritius **(Original)**
- Accommodation letter **(Original)**
  - a) Photocopy of Proof of address in Mauritius - any utility bill (water, electricity or telephone) over the last 3 months
  - b) Photocopy of ID of Accommodation owner
- A medical certificate along with the laboratory reports certifying that the applicant is not suffering from any contagious or infectious disease. A test for HIV, Hepatitis B, a Chest X-Ray carried out in his/her country of origin **(Original)**

We strongly recommend that you visit your local doctor and have a medical check and clearance for the above conditions before coming to Mauritius. If you are found to have any of the above conditions whilst you are in Mauritius, the provisional entry permit will be cancelled, and you will be required to leave Mauritius within two (2) weeks.

**Note:** You will have to undergo another medical check-up upon your arrival. You will be required to produce a medical certificate certifying that you are not suffering from any contagious or infectious disease. **A test of HIV, Hepatitis B and a chest X-Ray should be done at any private laboratory/clinic/hospital in Mauritius and the Medical Certificate should be submitted to the Passport and Immigration Office not later than one month after student arrival in Mauritius.**

The above documents are required by the Passport and Immigration Office in Mauritius and we will submit those along with the below-mentioned documents to Passport and Immigration Office (PIO), Port Louis for the issue of your visa.

These documents are required by the immigration authorities in Mauritius and we will submit the documents along with the below-mentioned documents to Passport and Immigration Office (PIO), Port Louis for issue of your visa.

1. Original letter of admission from Charles Telfair Campus
2. Receipt for the payment of tuition fees

3. Accreditation letter from HEC or MQA
4. Certificate of Registration of Institution

The Passport and Immigration Office (PIO) normally processes the documents within 12 working days and sends to Prime Minister's Office (PMO), this may be longer for some countries and we will advise you accordingly. The PMO works on the documents for approximately 10 working days and then returns with approval to PIO, the PIO takes approximately 3 days to issue the Residence Permit. i.e. the process usually takes around 3 weeks but could be longer at busy periods so please do make your application as early as possible to avoid disappointment.

Your attention is drawn to the fact that non-citizens travelling to Mauritius as Tourist/Visitors will not be issued with any permit or extension of visa to study/follow course.

### **Medical**

A fully comprehensive medical insurance is compulsory.
